Dear Friends and Family:

We are having an impact! That's right... You and I are being used by God **to bring about change in Uganda!** I had the privilege of attending our third and final conference for female church leaders in Masaka, Uganda several weeks ago. While **interviewing 5 of the dozens of women** who attended all three of our conferences, I asked them one question, **"How have these conferences impacted your life?"** The *answers amazed* me. See if they amaze you, too.



Meet **Sarah** from Soroti, a town in eastern Uganda. She had a teaching ministry, but lacked confidence in herself as a teacher. She too was helped by the bible study methods course. But perhaps more importantly she was struggling with the issue of losing her salvation.

Meet **Jessica** from Kasese, a town located in far western Uganda. Jessica is a social worker who develops projects for women that bring about economic change. For her, the bible study methods course was a transformational course because it now allows her to read Scripture more effectively. *"Now if I read a passage in the Bible, I am able to analyze and ask myself: who wrote this book? Why did he write it? What was the situation? What does God want me to do about this? Is there anything I should explore? Is there any promise? Is there any command? I am able to read it more effectively and understand it better than I used to because of these courses."*



"These conferences have left an impact in my life in that some of the questions about my salvation have been answered. I have not been sure of the God I have been serving and of the plan of salvation that He has. So the teachings have given me a foundation to understand that I am not on the wrong track."

Meet **Betty**, also from Soroti, Uganda. A dynamic, energetic worship leader at her church, she is also a wife, mother and emerging leader in her community. *"My life has not remained the same since attending these conferences. My spiritual life was changed; even economically my family changed because the teachings changed my life and opened my understanding of what I could do as a woman."*



Isn't it amazing what God has done through all of us? Isn't it amazing how much these women value what they've been taught? We see it in **their personal commitment to study Scripture** and in **their commitment to share** what they've learned with others. **We too are committed**---to do more for the cause of Christ. *Will you commit to doing more* for the cause of Christ through this ministry? **Will you consider at least sharing this newsletter** with others who might want to join us in doing God's work in Africa?

We **thank you** for partnering with us and would love to hear from you. To God be the glory...

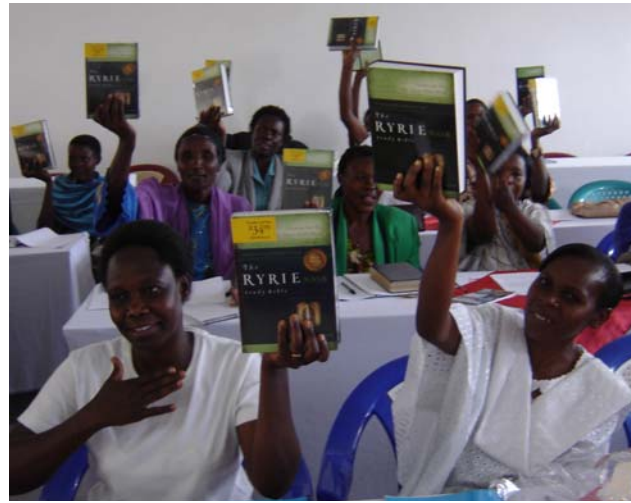
